COMMENT: Supernations like China are having a major impact on Global Markets, and this card is here to open up your eyes on some important data points. It helps making things smaller. For starters, let's talk about NATIONS. Certain nations rely heavily on China. China is Chile's biggest Trading Partner. For Mexico, #1 supplier of cars to MEXICO is CHINA nowadays. And China has capacity to deliver HALF of the World's demand for vehicles now. In Africa, 35 COUNTRIES are the number of African countries that China is involved with building its infrastructure. That's a lot. A LOT. North Korea is next. Around 90% of North Korea's exportations go to just one country: CHINA. Then next, Latin America. Around \$136 billion in CHINESE LOANS were made to several countries of Latin America and The Caribbean making them too dependent on CHINA. About 123 CHINESE LOANS were distributed to Brazil, Ecuador and Venezuela in recent years by China. The 2nd largest Trading Partner of Latin America and The Caribbean is now CHINA (as of 2021). It increased its trade volume by almost 40x (!). THE CONTINENT. A WHOLE CONTINENT. Huge, right? REMEMER one thing: 35% of Global GDP growth comes from China. The United States? Exactly 5x more is the deficit of The USA regarding China. The country buys 5x more from China (imports) than sells (exports) to the asian nation. This is just for you to have an idea on how Global Markets are relying on China. Additionally, 78% of U.S. weapons systems are dependent on Chinese materials (rare earths). And 60% of Walmart's inventory is imported from China. The company has 1.6 million employees across 4,600 locations in The USA, and it's the largest private employer of the country. Furthermore, 4-5 months is the amount of time required for China to manufacture and ship toys to The USA. And 80% of the organic food consumed in The USA is imported from countries like China and Turkey (!). FOODs, GROCERIES, TOYS, WEAPONS.....amazing, And this is just the tip of the iceberg. There's a lot more to say. But for now this card is done. More on China later.
